

## Learning Activity

The following activities are designed to put all the reading you just completed into action and provide you with a sense of comfort with the lesson materials, the topics discussed, and ultimately prepare you for the upcoming assignments and portfolio creation. These will be submitted as part of your Week 2 discussion.

1. Create a new Photoshop Document by importing the Colour Wheel template into Photoshop CC.
2. It is your choice if you use the blank template or the completed colour wheel as these will ultimately be used for your reference when completing the other worksheets.
3. If using the blank template:
4. Use the Colour Picker, Eyedropper, and Paint Bucket tools to colour in your colour wheel
5. Using the Colour Wheel as a guide, import the Colour Schemes 1, Colour Schemes 2, Colour Designs 1, and Colour Designs 2 worksheets into Photoshop and use the Eyedropper and Paint Bucket tools to fill in each Colour Harmony to the best of your ability.
6. If necessary, use Google searches to help you choose the colours correctly
7. Save each worksheet as JPEG files using the naming structure
